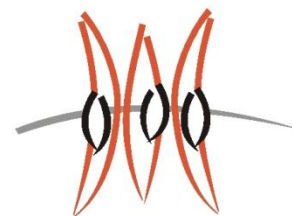

Is this course for you?

This course is for people working in or interested in working as a personal carer or looking after people in an aged care setting.

Pre-Requisites

Prior to commencing work experience a police clearance will need to be sighted.

Learning outcomes

The course consists of 14 units of competency enabling you to:

- Understand the process of ageing and how it effects the body;
- Provide support and personal care needs using individual plans to an older persons physical, emotional and behavioural needs;
- Work in the community care sector; understanding teamwork, diversity, information provided, work effectively and reporting;
- Interview and communicate with older people and team members;
- Follow safety procedures in the aged care sector;
- Provide information and report to team members in a verbal and written form.

Recognition of Prior learning (RPL)

If you have prior experience working in the Aged Care or community sector an upfront RPL can be conducted. Discuss further with McCusker.
