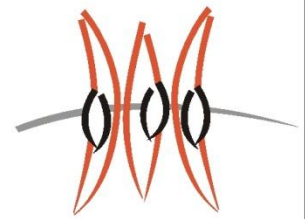

Is this course for you?

This course provides accredited entry level training for employment in community based services. The focus is on providing direct care and support for people with disabilities and older people within their own homes.

Pre-Requisites

Prior to commencing work experience a police clearance will need to be sighted.

Learning outcomes

The course includes 14 units of competency enabling you to:

- Develop the skills and knowledge to support and empower individual clients
- Meet the needs of the elderly and the disabled and provide direct care and support
- Deal with complex care issues such as challenging behaviours, dementia, cultural diversity
- Understand the role of the home and community care employee.
- Work with other carers and support staff
- Understand and follow safety for direct care work

Career pathway

This course is suitable for people who want jobs such as field worker, personal care assistant or home care assistant.

When you finish this course you can continue through Certificate IV or Diploma courses in Community Services, Community Welfare Work, Youth Work, Mental Health, Disabilities and Alcohol and Other Drug Work.

Recognition of Prior learning (RPL)

Relevant life and work experience can be considered through an upfront RPL. Discuss further with McCusker.
