

# Certificate IV in Aged Care CHC 40108

## Overview

A Certificate IV in Aged Care enables carers to work in residential facilities or client homes within defined organisational guidelines and service plans. These people may provide services to individuals with complex needs, and/or work with groups of older people. Work may include training and support to promote independence and community participation through activities and programs in a variety of settings including residential and centre based programs.

## Is this course for you?

This course is for people who report to service managers and liaise with professionals and other service providers. You may be required to supervise and/or coordinate a limited number of other workers; have an understanding of Indigenous culture and history and to work with local communities in the provision of services.

## Pre-Requisites

Certificate III in Aged Care Work, Certificate III in Community Services (Aged Care Work) or Certificate III in Home and Community Care will be beneficial.

## Learning outcomes

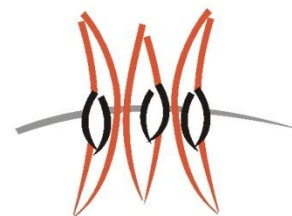
Includes 15 units (plus 6 Cert III units as pre-requisites) of competency covering:

- Facilitate support to older persons and individuals with complex needs including monitoring service delivery plans and other services
- Source, organise and deliver client services / Utilise specialist communication skills to build strong relationships
- Coordinate organisational information systems
- Work within legal and ethical frameworks
- Provide assistance to the elderly to maintain their safety and well being including dementia support
- Understanding of medication administration and distribution, policies and procedures.

## Recognition of Prior learning (RPL)

Units of Competency from your Certificate III qualification may count towards the Certificate IV in Aged Care Work. Training conducted by your facility may also be recognised.
