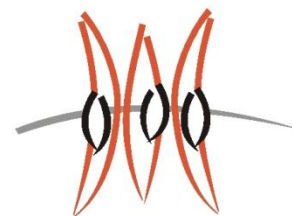

## Is this course for you?

This course is for people who are seeking career opportunities in designing (assist), conducting and evaluating day activity programs to promote health and well being in one or more sector areas. You may be responsible for other workers, and work may be under professional supervision within defined organisational guidelines or as a sole practitioner.

## Pre-Requisites

Certificate III in Aged Care Work or Certificate III in Home and Community Care may assist in this program however is not mandatory.

## Learning outcomes

Includes 16 units of competency enabling you to:

- Develop the skills and knowledge to assist in the design, implementation and evaluation of health and leisure for clients
- Develop leisure and health programming skills for groups and individuals and for clients with complex needs
- Confirm physical health status
- Understand legal and ethical considerations and work within workplace safety
- Develop specialist communication skills to build relationships.

## Recognition of Prior learning (RPL)

Units of Competency from your Certificate III qualification may count towards the Certificate IV in Aged Care Work. Training conducted by your facility may also be recognised.
